“Deep, dark plummy fruitcake stuff; smells really dense. There’s complex flake tobacco and currant too, which builds the longer the wine sits in the glass. Attacks with really slick, dark berries, building chewy tannin and lovely, pippy, tangy stuff. Has sweet-savoury, prosciutto-like characters too and forceful cabernet sauvignon tannin. Needs slopping about a bit if you want to enjoy it young. Otherwise stash it for 6 years.”
