HOWARD PARK ABERCROMBIE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2005

“This is a stunningly good cabernet, the best vintage yet of the Howard Park flagship.

Over the years, its composition has changed both in terms of its grape varieties and its regional make-up. Called Abercrombie – a Burch family name – from this vintage, it is ultra-concentrated with ripe blackcurrant, black cherry and brambly flavours with a hint of tobacco leaf, all impeccably balanced with fine sweet tannins. It’s multi-layered, complex, elegant and plush.”
