“A hundred clicks or so south of Margaret River sits the Great Southern region, with its cooler climate and stonier soil. It is where Howard Park source the fruit for their Scotsdale Shiraz, and it is easy to see why. The result is a distinctly regional, individual style of Shiraz, peppery, perfumed and with an intriguing spicy/stony/dustiness about it. This is still only medium bodied, but has velvete black fruit flavours in harmony with the natural spice and pepper that is a traditional character of this wine. Super length, elegant, great balance; a lovely wine and in the top handful of WA Shiraz.”
