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## HOWARD PARK SCOTSDALE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2005

“The grapes for this bottle are sourced from a single estate in Mount Barker in Western Australia. The vines were planted in 1974 and are therefore 34 years old. Old vines and extra attention in the vineyard results in a higher quality wine, in this case one brimming with wonderful blackberry and bramble flavours laced with a herbal, dark chocolate edge. It is also blessed with a long length and tannins that should see it through for several years. In fact they recommend 5-8 years cellaring.
