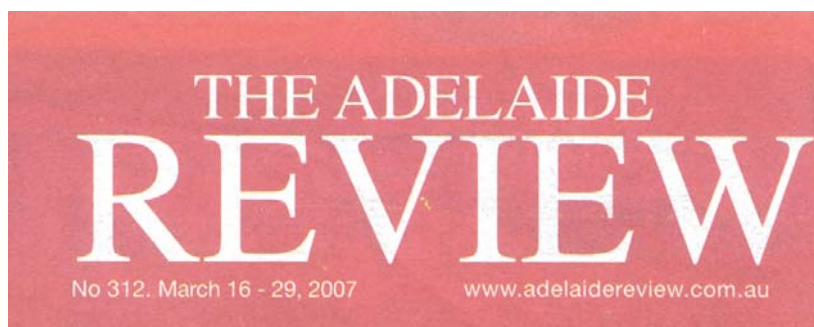

HOWARD PARK RIESLING 2006

93 Points

“With an impressive lineage since the first release in 1986, Howard Park riesling is a staple of any Australian riesling aficionado’s cellar. The 2006 vintage in Western Australia was incredibly cool, giving riesling the benefit of mild ripening conditions and an extended season. The nose is understated and elegant, showing citrus rind, lime zest, some bath salts and nice lifted aromatic perfume, a complete, complex set of characters. On the palate it carves out a defined mineral line, in fact, limes come from every angle. The acidity is a standout, fusing power and elegance together and striking impressive balance. Now to 2018.”
