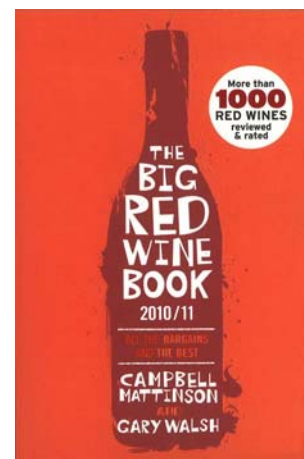

HOWARD PARK ABERCROMBIE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2008



“Howard Park has been making top-notch cabernet sauvignon for over twenty years but it’s pulled out a ripper from the 2008 vintage. This is what cabernet is all about. Long-flavoured, rich and regal, its potential for cellaring abundantly clear. This is a wine with both authority and softness; as with so many of the world’s best wines, this will drink beautifully in any situation, as a young wine and also once it’s old. This is a wine that melts in your mouth.”

“Just put your nose into this – it’s positively erotic for a cabernet fancier. Red fruits, some hints of liquorice, beautiful cedary oak, cassis black currant and violets. Medium bodied, firm but very fine. Beautiful shape and structure. Impeccable tannin. Length to burn. Just bottled but it shines. Top wine. Some tobaccoey cabernet flavours on exit. Not heavy. Classic.”
