## HOWARD PARK ABERCROMBIE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2008

“An absolutely supreme vintage of this masterful wine, the 2008 has the magic combination of aromatic cedary, cassis fruit matched by a firm structural core of fine-grained tannins. Too young to drink now it will begin to hit its straps in around 10 years’ time.”

“...The one winery that perhaps has done most to foster a fine wine reputation for this remote corner of Western Australia is Howard Park. Despite taking a portion of their flagship Abercrombie cabernet sauvignon from Margaret River, it is the Great Southern portion that produces, in good vintages, a wine with perfume, grace and longevity. A recent 10 year vertical tasting of Great Southern riesling from Howard Park also showed these wines can age better than many from the hallowed turf of South Australia’s Clare and Eden valleys. Add to that their exciting and world-class chardonnays, recently launched under the Marchand & Burch label, and it becomes clear that Great Southern and Pemberton are full of potential with a range of fine viticultural sites waiting to be uncovered.”
