“Great Southern riesling is typically austere and suited to ageing. The Howard Park '03 is a case in point: tight, undeveloped but loaded with potential. The nose has understated, musky floral and lime aromas. The palate lacks fruit richness at the moment but it's firmly constructed and high in acidity. My bet is that it will be superb, given bottle age.”

Ageing: Two to ten years.
