“Ruby-red. Dark berries and cherry jam on the nose, with earthy notes of exotic spices, dried flowers, espresso and coca powder. Lush in texture, with youthful, crunchy blackberry and boysenberry flavors framed by gentle tannins. This fairly weighty wine has beautiful fruit but needs time to stretch out. Juicy, fresh and long on the finish, with energetic, tangy dark berry fruit tones. One for the cellar, or at least the decanter.”
