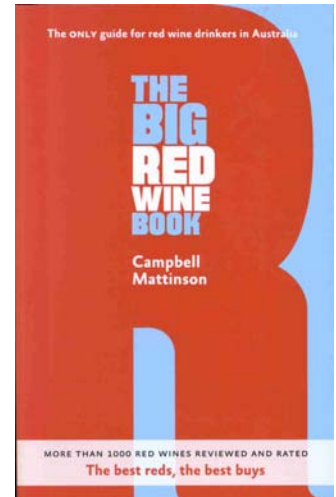

“Margaret River shiraz comes across as bulkier, and less spicy, than Great Southern Shiraz, a difference often highlighted in Howard Park’s single vineyard series. There’s some rum and raisin flavour here matched to chocolaty, cedary oak, supporting tannins equal to the thickness of the flavour. This is a red to sink your teeth into. Drink 2008 - 2016.”
