‘SCOTSDALE’ SHIRAZ 2004

“Deep, bright-rimmed ruby. Rich and spicy on the nose, with dark berry aromas and notes of dried flowers, cracked pepper and graphite. Fat and sweet on the palate, but the blackberry and cassis flavours are focused and brisk, and nicely firmed by fine-grained tannins that knit smoothly with the lush fruit. Spicy, sweet and long on the finish, with good lift and a tangy mineral note adding brightness.”
