“Sourced from Mount Barker, Great Southern vineyards and spends 36 months on lees to build complexity. Howard Park’s commitment and connections to sparkling wine and Champagne (they import/co-opt with some French producers) are telling an increasingly potent story.

Toasted brioche, some nuttiness, honey, lemon curd bouquet. Fleshy textured, ripe apple fruit flavours, zingy acid driven finish. Chalkiness to texture, really pure, driving, lemon-to-saline feel. Pretty brisk and refreshing style on hand here with some weight behind it.”
