2015 MARCHAND & BURCH PORONGURUP CHARDONNAY

“The Burch family and Pascal Marchand are going marvellous things with pinot noir and chardonnay. Their 2013 and 2014 (18.3 points and \$49.50) Mount Barrow pinot noirs were exciting, delicious and the just-released 2015 is reputed to be a step up; the chardonnays are better again. The 2015 is finely styled but is rounder, balanced, seamless and ready for classy and satisfying drinking. Despite its approachability on release, this youthful 2015 still has the dense and long fruit qualities and the subtle leanness and crispness towards the finish will ensure even more wonderful drinking around 2020. This wine has the rare extra-dimension that adds the intrigue, drawing you back again and again. The term we use is ‘life’, 18.5 points and \$73.”
