“It seems logical that the \$73 Marchand & Burch is far too young to release. Those people who spend \$70 or more on a bottle of wine are in most cases into wine (or just rich and dumb), so will know the wine’s glory time is yet to come. It’s made from the gin gin clone of chardonnay, which is recognised as the best in WA, and the vineyard is one of the oldest in the region. It’s a very fine wine indeed, with all parts in the right places, so will be worth the money asked. 92 points at tasting but several more to come as it ages.”
