The experts speak out

"A vibrant fruit streak runs through the core, with plums and black cherries overlaid by a sparkle of lifted violets. Spice, pepper, dry savoury herbs and a dab of pine sap fill out the background, with a little more spice evident on the palate of the cork-sealed example. Tannins are fine-grained and the length is average, although a little shorter under cork".
