2019 MARCHAND & BURCH SAVIGNY-LES-BEAUNE LES LAVIÈRES PREMIER CRU

Tasting Notes: Ruby red in the glass with wisps of purple that catch the light, this Pinot Noir possesses a sensational energy in its appearance, nose, and palate. Bright cherry, beeswax, blood orange, Campari, cocoa, rosemary, ricciarelli cookie, vanilla and wet soil present on an elegant yet restrained nose that opens up beautifully with a little bit of time. Mouth-filling and magnificently moreish, the palate is medium body with a fruit presence that enlivens the wine. Flavours of tart cranberry and cassis unfurl leading to a creeping acidity that glides along the mid palate ending in a fine tannin that preserves the flavour, drawing out the finish to a beautiful length. This wine's youthful vibrance makes it incredibly enjoyable to drink now yet it will certainly benefit from ageing to unlock the secondary and tertiary delights that lie waiting in reserve.

Vineyard: Our Lavières vineyard is located on the bottom of the hill down below our Savigny premier cru Vergelesses.

Soil: The Lavières name comes from lava which defined the type of limestone here. This particular soil provides very good drainage.

Maceration process: 50 % whole bunch. short cold maceration, two pigeage a day at the start of the alcoholic fermentation, then pump-overs during maceration for a gentle extraction.

Pressing: Pneumatic press

Total elevage: 16 months

Oak used: 20% new oak

Operations performed during ageing: One racking before bottling

Filtration: No fining, no filtration

All the vinification and ageing operations are carried out with reference to the lunar calendar

Cellaring: Drink now and over the next 10 years.

Alcohol 13.5%
