2019 MARCHAND & BURCH SAVIGNY-LES-BEAUNE LES PLANCHOTS

Tasting Notes: Charcuterie, ground allspice, raspberry, raw cocoa, exotic spice, and gamey aromatics build harmonically on the nose. The palate is soft and plush with notes of strawberry leading to a fresh red cherry core. Medium bodied with a velvety texture, balanced acidity and ripe powdery tannins, the amalgam of red fruit and spice sits pleasantly on the palate to form a long and delicious finish.

Vineyard: Our vineyard Les Planchots is located east of Savigny-Les-Beaune.

Soil: Clayey, calcareous soils with sandy nuances.

Maceration process: 100% de-stemmed. Light pumping over during maceration for a soft extraction.

Pressing: Pneumatic press

Total elevage: 18 months

Oak used: 15% new oak

Operations performed during ageing: One racking before bottling

Filtration: No fining, no filtration

All the vinification and ageing operations are carried out with reference to the lunar calendar

Cellaring: Enjoy this wine now in its vibrant youth or over the next 3 years

Alcohol 13.5%



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
